Dear Friends of The First Tee of Connecticut,

2017 was definitely a successful year and everyone reading this message should take pride in the fact that The First Tee of Connecticut introduced 74,801 young people to our Life Skills Curriculum and the game of golf. 2017 was also a year of expansion and transition.

On July 1 our chapter assumed sole responsibility for programs and operations in Fairfield County – specifically those at Fairchild Wheeler in Bridgeport. We welcome all those existing participants, coaches and volunteers to The First Tee of Connecticut family. In Fairfield County and across the state we continue to identify new golf facilities, schools and youth service agencies to partner with as we strive to expand our impact across the state.

Rick says golf is a global game that brings people together, and learning

the game builds and displays character. "The best part for me is watching the kids grow into fine young people through season after season. This year a former First Tee student even asked me to write a college recommendation for him - and he was accepted!"



3 Coach Profile:

Karen Michaels has been involved with The First Tee for five years - initially as a volunteer, now as a Level I Coach. She teaches team programs in Waterbury, Branford and New Haven; and group programs in Waterbury and Cromwell. Unlike the kids she coaches, Karen was a late bloomer. "I found and fell in love with golf in my 30's and am now dedicated to growing

the game. The First Tee of Connecticut does so much for the kids. It's amazing to see how they grow and develop in our programs." Perhaps it's karma; Karen was born the same year the PGA TOUR was born in Connecticut.

4 Teacher Profile:

Marcy Peschke has 825 kids. That's the number of students in her First Tee In-School Program at H.S. Chase Elementary School in Waterbury. Every single student in the school, Pre- K thru 5, participates. Marcy has been with The First Tee of Connecticut program for 10 years. "This program gives our students a chance to participate in an activity they might not

otherwise get a chance to do, and they love it. My goal is to give my students the opportunity to learn about health and wellness as well as teaching them activities they can participate in to create a healthy lifestyle, so this program fits our students to a TEE," Marcy says.



6 Facility Operator:

About 15 years and 8,000 kids later, Jeff DelRosso is still going "lights out" as owner of Prospect Golf Driving Range in Prospect, one of The First Tee of Connecticut's longest running program locations. "To expose golf to kids who may not be exposed is one of the best things about teaming up with The First Tee," says Jeff. "Teaching life skills and golf in a group setting teaches kids to be

interactive with others." Jeff has dozens of great First Tee stories of kids going on to bigger and better opportunities—from playing college golf to pursuing rewarding careers.



8 Board Member:

Skip Wyatt, CEO/Owner, Mr. Handyman and HM Remodeling of Greater Fairfield County, went from a career in mainframes at IBM to help framing young lives as a Board Member with The First Tee of Connecticut. "I try to lend insight to help underserved youth in Fairfield County. My mission is to make the Fairfield County First Tee program as robust as the rest of

Connecticut so I'm glad to see how programs have flourished," Skip says. The First Tee also provides benefits to Skip on a personal level: "It's very gratifying to know that we're helping kids, especially kids in urban areas to be exposed to golf and The First Tee's Nine Core Values."



5 New Board Member:

Dan Martinez, 30, may just be the most veteran of The First Tee of Connecticut's alumni. Dan started as a 10-year old in 1998 in Hartford when the Chapter was known as The First Tee of Hartford. His favorite of the Nine Core Values—"The First Tee helped me grasp the importance of 'Confidence' at an early age," Dan says. "The First Tee also taught me the importance

of networking and not to be afraid to reach out." Today, Dan rubs elbows (literally) with some of the biggest names in sports as Marketing Manager for ESPN Deportes in New York City. His sister Sadie soon followed in Dan's footsteps in the sand (bunkers) as a participant of The First Tee of Connecticut, too, and has gone on to a career in golf.



7 Participant:

18-year old Andrew Maslar of Monroe is entering his freshman year at Florida Gulf Coast University, where he'll study Professional Golf Course Management. Andrew participated in The First Tee of Connecticut for six years and wants to make a career out of golf. "Learning life skills from The First Tee helped shape who I am today," Andrew says. The First Tee of

Connecticut opens doors: "The First Tee of Connecticut introduced me to the Travelers Championship where I was part of the maintenance crew and also was an amateur caddy at the Pro Ams."



9 The Right Course:

David Corrado, PGA professional, is living two dreams. As General Manager and Director of Golf at TPC River Highlands, David hosts the PGA TOUR'S Travelers Championship. David also helps grow young lives: "TPC River Highlands and The First Tee of Connecticut are great partners—we share the practice facility used by the PGA Tour pros as well as

maintaining The First Tee's Karl Krapek Family Learning Links." David is also on the Advisory Council for our Walmart Charity Classic, a Travelers Championship kick-off event. David shares not only common ground with The First Tee but common goals—"We both want to grow the game while instilling the right core values for our youth."

Meghna Mazumdar, Ted May Headline National Summit

First it was winning a spot with Rory McIlroy at the 2016 Wells Fargo Championship. Now, The First Tee of Connecticut's Meghna Mazumdar made headlines again. At The First Tee's 20th anniversary Network Meeting (Nov. 8-11, 2017) in Orlando, Meghna Mazumdar, a ninth grader at South Windsor High School, was announced as one of two recipients of The First Tee's Outstanding Participant award. This national award recognizes exemplary achievement in the area of academics, community service, chapter involvement and leadership. Meghna received a \$20,000 college scholarship from The First Tee Founding Corporate Partner Shell Oil Company. They took the stage shortly after Former President George W. Bush, the

organization's honorary chair, addressed the crowd of more than 1,000 people.

The First Tee also presented other national recognitions and awards throughout the Network Meeting. Ted May, immediate past Chair of The First Tee of Connecticut's board, was one of two who were honored with the Jack Stephens Leadership Award for outstanding service, leadership and commitment to the organization's mission.

The 20th Anniversary Network Meeting was kicked off with a performance by Javier Colon, Honorary Director of The First Tee of Connecticut and winner of the inaugural season of the NBC television show, "The Voice".

The spring season featured our annual Parent-Child event at Lyman Orchard's Apple Nine, the first of several LPGA-USGA Girls Golf programs including "Bring A Friend" Day and weekly programs across the state. As the spring season wrapped up, the Travelers Championship came to town and offered participants several unique opportunities to interact with PGA TOUR Professionals including participation in the Eversource PGA TOUR Player Experience for Junior Golfers.

Once school let out for the summer several events including the Travel Team

program, the Nutmeg State Games and the East Mountain Junior Open allowed participants to test their "golf skills" on the course while several participants attended national opportunities where they could showcase their "life skills." We are proud to share the success stories of those participants who represented our chapter at The First Tee events across the country on the previous pages.

In 2017 eight sessions of our popular Summer Camp were offered for young people. A few of these weeks were dedicated to "Girls Only" and to our

youngest friends within the TARGET Level for ages 5 & 6. Summer Camp includes plenty of practice on and around the golf course, and even some extracurricular activities like a water balloon toss and dodgeball. The week concludes with an Open House for families featuring awards and an ice cream party.

Despite popular opinion, the fall season brings almost as many participants as the rest of the year, proving again that the golf season does not end when school resumes!

Those are just a few examples of The First Tee's "Activity-Based" approach to seamlessly incorporating important Life Skills within golf activities. The Life Skills Experience is at the heart of what The First Tee is all about.

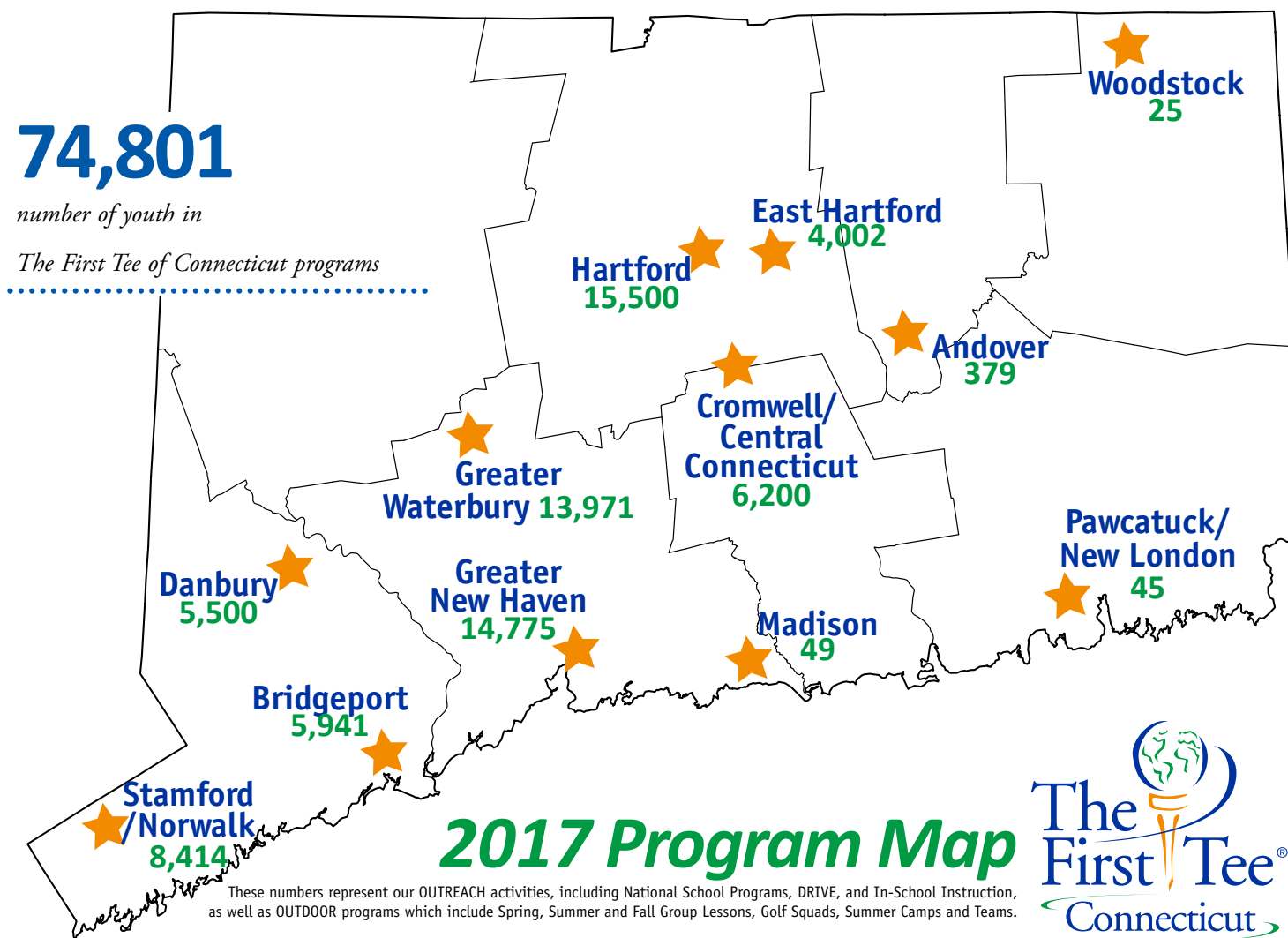
Chris LaBonte

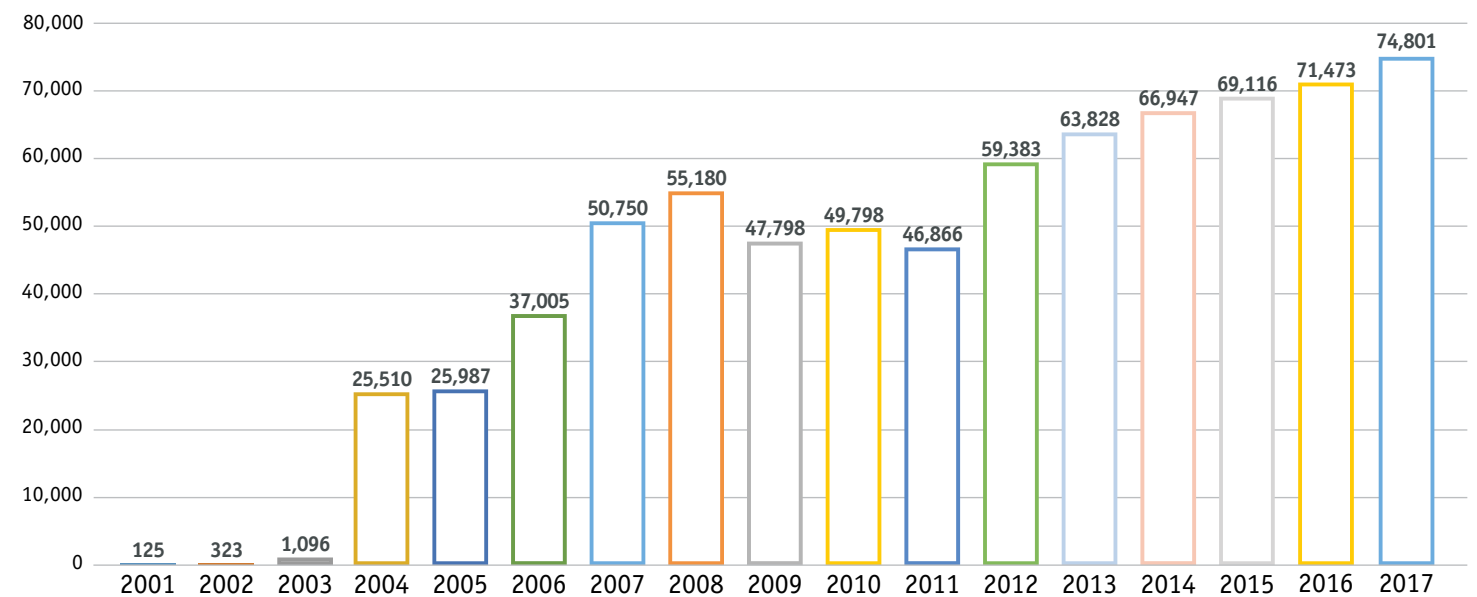

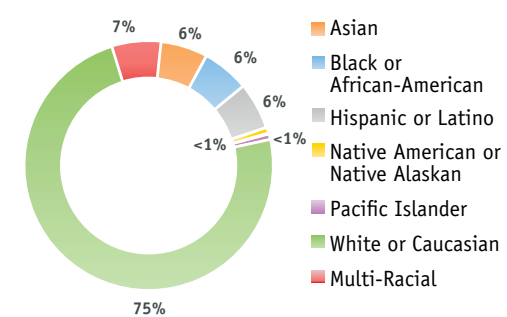

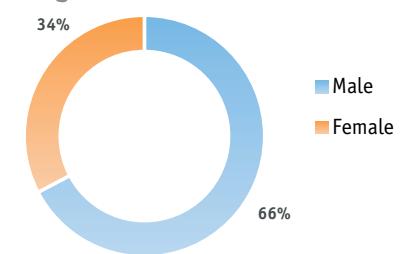
The First Tee of Connecticut Program History Total participants served



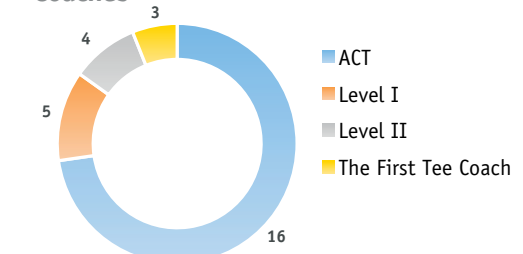
Registered Ethnicity (Non-Caucasian Goal: 33%)



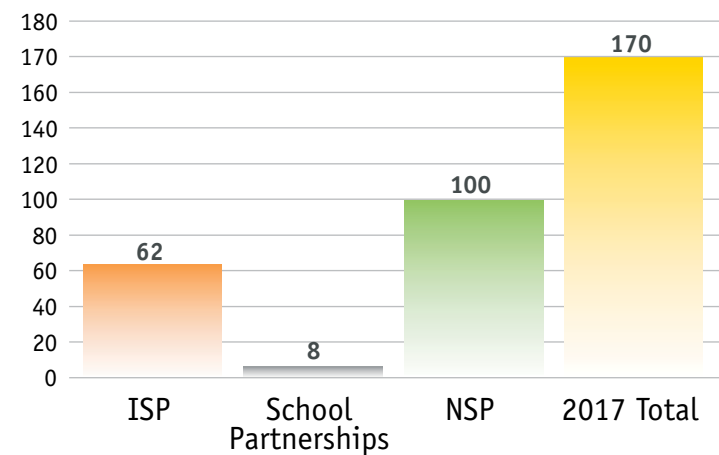
Registered Gender (Female Goal: 35%)



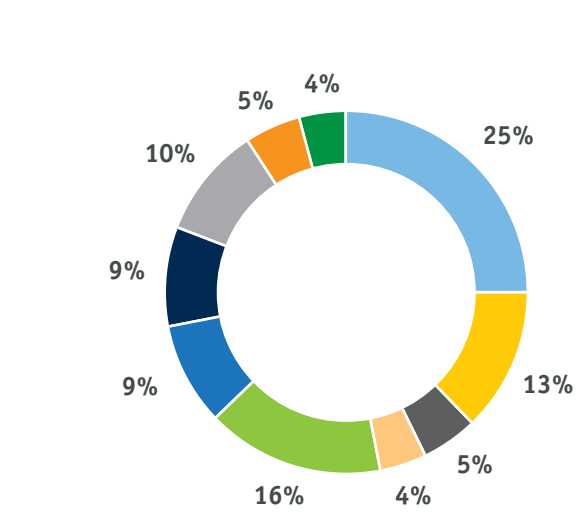

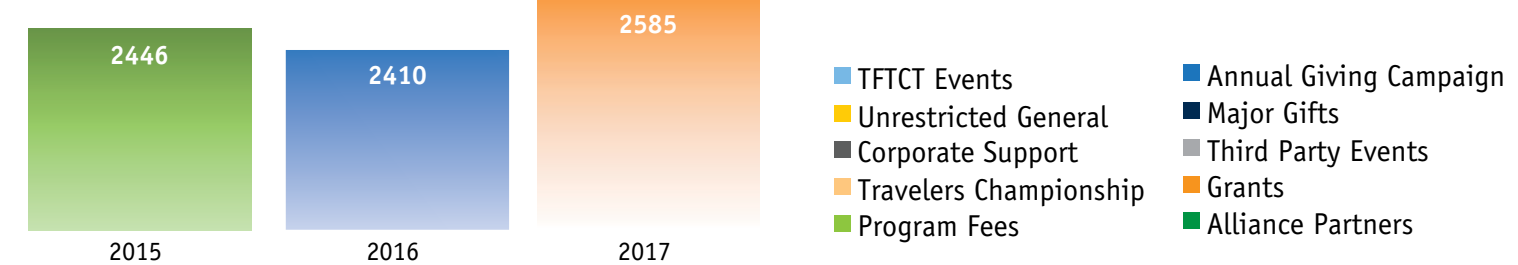

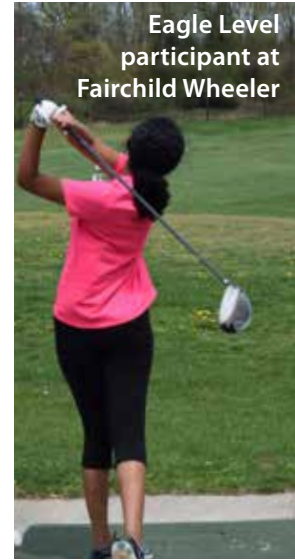
